#### Road - Ken Houlberg

Regional Club Road and Track Ranking: PNECC currently sits 8th with 109 regional points. (44 points to best the most recent 2019 season end total of 152).

Club Points: Our club captain, Tim Lawn currently leads the club leader board (of 10 scoring riders) with 19 points, followed closely by Callum Baxter (18) and Nick Rhodes (18). PNECC's new junior riders, Jonty King, finished a creditable 4<sup>th</sup> in his first regional road race championships on the PNECC course at Owslebury on 11 June and it is a delight to see how proud he is to race in his new (to him) PNE skin suit. Our other junior racer, George Williams, competed in and finished his first Cat 3/4 race at the Dick Evans Memorial #4 on 15 June with a brave and hugely creditable ride. For him to have finished in such a large and competitive Cat 3 field on Portsmouth's Mountbatten circuit indicates considerable future potential. Very well done to both riders.

PNE female racers continue to compete in regional events led by Fran Marshman, Jo Lovall and Megan Johnson. A number of our women's race team have asked how we may better support women's racing locally. How to encourage enough women to participate in racing to make local events viable is a hot topic regionally and one our committee is frequently considering. I welcome ideas and proposals and am keen to consider all options – it is a priority for our club.

The clubs 2022 racing programme is proceeding successfully with support from volunteers and very good participation. Our focus is on high quality, safe, enjoyable events for all involved.

PNECC Dick Evans Memorial Summer Series The series is now well underway with 4 of the 10 races already held. Participation by regional racers has been good and track utilisation excellent. Incrementally we are marching towards a break even point for these races, with 65 and 66 racers participating respectively in each of the last two events. The events have been well supported by PNE riders (10 in DEM #4), volunteers / supporters and life and committee members. The feedback from racers and youth parents has universally been superb with many commenting on the positive experience and welcome on arrival. BC South is hugely appreciative and supportive of what PNECC is doing. We seem to be on the right track. Round 5 is 29th June

#### Key headlines:

- Participation/ Utilisation levels per race are reaching, or exceeding target. The club and local community
  are working together to promote the series, events and venue experience positively
- PNECC support for youth racing is being widely recognised and welcomed by Solent Pirates, Venta and Sotonia amongst others.
- Youth racing is put on at cost and underpins the future for British Cycling. BC are considering PNECC request for more support for youth race organisers at their July Board meeting
- The participation target is for 10 more adult entries each Wednesday.
- BC South are investigating ways to help organisers with reducing costs. This includes potential block bookings of events.
- The club will invite and host visitors to present the event and seek support for developing use and future events.

PNE Summer Road Race (inc South Region Junior Championships): The race took place 11th June with a full field including 3 PNE racing. The event drew teams from Guernsey, Wales and the Midlands 15 club volunteers supported the event on the day. Officials supported from across regions (the Women's Tour on the same demanded significant numbers of officials). Road and weather conditions were excellent. Racing was to a high standard, and considered prestigious by participants, attendees and supporters.

3 junior club members took the opportunity to spend the day as part of the race officials convoy, riding in the race convoy and had an enjoyable experience.
