- e. Proposal from Peter Mac Set up a PNECC Hub at Mountbatten: Storage area for kit/ equipment/ club archives/ unawarded trophies etc that has secure flexible access to collect/ return and share kit between volunteers/ event organisers.
  - 1. Basis of the approach area with sole access under control of the club secretary, 12 month min agreement, thereafter rolling agreement unless renewed. 3 months notice, relocation costs paid in the event of changing the allocated space.

f. Proposal from Peter Mac – Volunteer development: Funding of expenses (i.e travel) incurred for club volunteers training/ certifying as officials to support the club race programme, notably circuit commissaires/ road race marshals.

### Road - Ken Houlberg/Mark Williams

#### Ken Houlberg

2022 club event feedback provided by Dan Coast BC South\*\* to Ken and shared at the meeting. Overall teh events were very successful exceeding expectations, notably increasing new rider numbers. Dan's comments provide PNE committee with some useful data ahead of any considerations we make about organising racing next year.

Challenges are to prepare the early season and avoid too many events in the June/ July/ August period. The process to submit 2023 event proposals will open shortly to decide the 2023 regional calendar.

The draft club race event calendar has been distributed for comment. Event bookings and contact with sponsors are prepared. The approach is based on lessons from 2022 and improvements. The club shall seek to maintain and or reduce costs to participants despite inflation in event and event support costs. The club shall seek support to deliver this objective with partners and sponsors

. Ken, Mark and Matt will explain and seek support from the racers to volunteer at the Road Race in addition to participating in the circuit events. Aslo to provide plenty of advance notice. Peter will take the role as Road Race Organiser, succeeding Mark.

\*\*Note make that the Club Mountbatten race participant catchment covers BC South and South East.

## Time trial - David Knight

The 2022 time trial season has concluded, well done to the winners:

- Glenn Syder Point Salver James Ayton
- Road Bike League Alan Cockram
- Hill Climb Carl Fiford
- Team Time Trial The Dementors (Tim & Matt)
- Fixed Gear James Ayton

We had 220 entries into our club events, of which 96 were PNECC riders (similar to 2021). This successfully covered the event cost and expenses, affiliation for 2023 and CTT levies have been paid.

Proposals: Going forward we need to agree on: (refer to Minutes section 7 for decision)

- 3/. revisions to league rules.

PNECC should have a road bike specific trophy that looks as good as the Glen Syder.

### CX & Track - Alan Collins

#### CX - Wessex League

6 Adults and 1 under 10 raced in the 1<sup>st</sup> Round of the Wessex League at the Solent Pirates event in Clanfield. It was great to see the participation and enjoyment experienced by the 1<sup>st</sup> timers on the fast dry course. Round 2 FWCC in Romsey was cancelled due to the National Mourning period for the Queen. Rounds 3 & 4 are in Swindon, and Round 5 in Reading. These are not considered local enough to garner a PNE team entry


